Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.129 dated 20.9.2021 registered under Sections 61, 78, 1, 14 of Excise Act at Police Station City, Dhuri, District Sangrur.

Counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation in compliance of order dated 29.10.2021 passed by this Court. This fact has not been refuted by the State counsel who on instructions from HC Jagdeep Singh submitted that the petitioner is not required for any further investigation or custodial interrogation in the present case.

Present case is relating to recovery of 320 bottles of countrymade liquor, (for sale in Haryana) from one car whose driver was apprehended at the spot while two other occupants of the car succeeded in escaping from there. So, in this case, recovery has already been effected.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and order

of interim bail dated 29.10.2021 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
