Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during the pendency of the petition, the respondents have issued another instructions dated 04.03.2020, which have been amended on 11.05.2022 and the case of the petitioner is fully covered for the grant of relief as claimed in the present petition by the said instructions.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the petitioner files any representation claiming the relief under the instructions as being argued, appropriate decision on the prayer of the petitioner, will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of any such representation and in case it is found that the petitioner is entitled for the relief, the same will also be extended to her within a further period of four

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to file appropriate representation claiming the relief under the instructions dated 04.03.2020 as amended on 11.05.2022.
