JASGURPREET SINGH PURI, J (Oral):

The present matter was taken up twice. No one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner.

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of the order dated 07.06.2022 (Annexure P-4), whereby the bail bond of the petitioner was cancelled and further non bailable warrants were issued.

This Court while issuing notice on 15.09.2022, directed the petitioner to appear before the learned Appellate Court within a period of 10 days on the basis of undertaking given by the counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner would surrender before the Appellate Court within a period of 10 days.

However, today, the learned State counsel has submitted on

instructions from Inspector Gurnesher that though more than 3 months have been elapsed yet the petitioner has not surrendered despite the fact that only 10 days time was granted to him in this regard.

In view of the aforesaid factual position as stated by the learned State counsel whereby the petitioner has violated the order passed by this Court, the present petition is hereby dismissed.

Interim order passed on 15.09.2022 stands vacated.
