1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 30.09.2020, in CWP-15882-2020.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1, reveals that CWP-15882-2020, was disposed of vide order dated 30.09.2020, by directing the respondents to decide representation/ legal notice dated 28.08.2020, served by the petitioner by passing a speaking order, within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. On the last date, learned counsel for UT Chandigarh had produced copy of speaking order dated 25.03.2022. However, the matter was adjourned to today on account of none being present on behalf of the petitioner.

4. Today, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view

of speaking order dated 25.03.2022, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order dated 25.03.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

5. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
