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 This is claimants' appeal seeking modification of
award passed by MACT, Palwal.

 On request, the instant matter is taken up in National
Lok Adalat, accordingly discussed.

 As per statements of learned counsel for the
appellants and learned counsel for the Insurance Company
(separately recorded), a sum of Rs.5,75,000/- (Rupees Five Lac
Seventy Five Thousand Only) over and above the amount already
awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full &
final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement
of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be
disbursed to all the appellants in the same ratio as determined
by the learned MACT.

 Accordingly, we dispose off this case with a direction
to the Insurance Company to deposit four crossed-cheques, one
for Rs.2,44,375/- favouring appellant No.1, two in the sum of
Rs.1,20,750/- each favouring appellants No.2 & 3 and one for
Rs.89,125/- favouring appellant No.4 with the Office of the Lok
Adalat of the High Court within four weeks from today, in
compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum

shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheques to learned counsel/representative of the respondent - Insurance Company. The appellants' counsel/appellants may collect the cheques from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of this order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
