Case heard by video conferencing.

By CRM-M-45742 of 2021, the petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.37, dated 08.04.2021, registered at Police Station Meharban, Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana, alleging therein the commission of an offence punishable under Section 420 the IPC; with the petitioners in CRM-M-45781-2021 seeking quashing of FIR no. 92 dated 13.07.2020, registered at the same Police Station, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 323/341/506/380/34 of the IPC, as also all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of a compromise (copy Annexure

P2 respectively), arrived at between the petitioners and the 'private respondents' in each petition.

Pursuant to the orders of this court dated 01.12.2021, two reports of have been received from the learned JMIC, Ludhiana, both dated 14.01.2022, in the context of both these petitions seeking quashing of two separate FIRs, registered at the instance of the same complainant, i.e. Harmahinder Singh alias Harminder Singh, since deceased.

As per the said reports, firstly, the statements of all parties concerned, i.e. of respondents no.2 and 3 in CRM-M-45742-2021 (legal heirs of the complainant in the FIR), namely Rupinder Singh alias Sabi and Sharanjit Kaur, son and daughter respectively of Harminder Singh, were recorded, as were the statements of the petitioners in these two petitions, (separately in respect of each FIR), with the statement of the investigating officer also having been recorded, to the effect that there was no other accused in the matter other than the petitioner in CRM-M-45742-2021 (in FIR no.37/2021) and both the petitioners in CRM-M-45781-2021 (in FIR no.98/2021).

As per that court, it had also been determined that other than respondents no.2 and 3 in each petition, there is no other legal heir of the deceased complainant.

From the statements of the parties, as per the assessment of that court, the compromise between them has been arrived at of their own free will.

That being so, looking at the nature of the offences alleged to have been committed, the present petitions are allowed and FIR No.37, dated

08.04.2021 and FIR no.92 of 13.07.2020, both registered at Police Station Meharban, Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Section 420 of the IPC and Sections 323/341/506/34/380 thereof, respectively, along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, are hereby quashed.
