Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.33 dated 31.1.2021 registered under Sections 379, 411 IPC at Police Station I.M.T. Rohtak, District Rohtak.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that recovery of stolen batteries has already been effected and the petitioner has joined the investigation in compliance of order dated 13.9.2022 passed by this Court. State counsel on instructions from HC Davinder has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by the counsel for the petitioner and further submits that the recovery of stolen batteries has already been effected and the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

In view of the above as the recovery has already been effected

petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 13.9.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
