As per the petition, the following prayer was made:-

“Petition under section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure, thereby praying for the issuance of directions to the respondents no. 1 to 3 to file the status report in FIR No. 143, Dated 26.10.2020, registered at Police Station-Alewa, (under Section 346, and add section of POSCO Act for heinous crime against Children and add section 376 IPC also an issue direction to arrest the respondents and direct the Illaga Magistrate / Trial Court to record statement u/s 164 CRPC of victim again as she has given her earlier statement under pressure of respondents.

It is further prayed that directions may be issued to official respondents to decide the representation (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner, in the interest of justice.

It is further prayed that this Hon'ble Court may kindly pass any suitable order or direction, which may be deemed fit in the peculiar facts and circumstances of the instant case.”

2. Today, learned State counsel apprise the Court that the charges already stand framed by the trial Court and now the same is fixed for prosecution evidence.

3. Considering the aforesaid position, nothing survives in the present petition to be adjudicated. The petition is thus dismissed as having been rendered infructuous. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the present petition, in case he feels that any of his grievance still survives.
