 On request, the instant matter taken in Bi-Monthly Lok Adalat,
accordingly discussed.

 As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellant,
learned counsel for respondent No.3-Cholamandalam General Insurance
Company and learned counsel & representative of respondent No.5-National
Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees
Five Lacs Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is
allowed to the appellant in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal
and out of the aforesaid sum of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lacs Only), 70%
of the amount, i.e. Rs.3,50,000/- (Rupees Three Lacs and Fifty Thousand
Only) would be paid by respondent No.3 and 30% of the amount, i.e.
Rs.1,50,000/- (Rupees One Lac and Fifty Thousand Only) would be paid by
respondent No.5. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant,
the enhanced amount be paid to appellant-Chainpal.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the appellant to provide his Bank details to respondent No.3-Cholamandalam General Insurance Company and respondent No.5-National Insurance Company within one week from today. Pursuant thereto, both the Insurance Companies will deposit the agreed respective amounts in the Bank Account of appellant within three weeks thereafter. In case of failure to provide the Bank details by appellant, both the Insurance Companies shall deposit the respective crossed cheques in his favour drawn on any nationalized Bank with Lok Adalat of the High Court. In case of delay on the part of Insurance Companies, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipts after receiving the cheques to learned counsel/representative of respondent No.3-Cholamandalam General Insurance Company and respondent No.5-National Insurance Company. The appellant's counsel/appellant may collect the cheque from the Office of Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
