1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 06.05.2022, in CWP-9494-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 reveals that while issuing notice of motion in CWP-9494-2022 and ordering it to be heard along with CWP-19180-2021, same interim orders were passed as in CWP-19180-2021. However, a perusal of order dated 04.04.2022, in CWP-19180-2021, reveals that while adjourning the case to 28.04.2022, it was ordered that in case the respondents had stopped payment of pension to the petitioners, the said action be not given effect to till the next date of hearing.

3. Learned DAG, Haryana, has produced copy of email dated 20.10.2022 sent by the Treasury Officer, Narnaul, to the aided schools, indicating therein that amount of Rs.1,74,435/-, Rs.1,60,100/-,

Rs.2,65,965/- and Rs.1,74,605/- has been paid to the petitioners

respectively on 20.10.2022. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners. Learned DAG, Haryana, further state that during the pendency of the writ petition, payment of pension would be made to the petitioners on the due date for the succeeding months also. The email as referred to above is taken on record.

4. Accordingly, in view of the position noted above as well as assurance held out by the learned DAG, Haryana, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
