The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.07 dated 14.02.2017 registered under Sections 341, 323, 379-B, 148, 149 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Jaurkian, Tehsil Sardulgarh, District Mansa.

On November 02, 2021, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Case taken up through video conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter-alia contends that the petitioner, who is a 36 year old lady, had sought and got anticipatory bail from this Court on 22.05.2017; she had been appearing before the Trial Court on all subsequent dates in her trial; on 19.10.2021 she could not appear before the Trial Court due to ill health but for bona fide reasons could not communicate the same to her lawyer appearing for her before the Trial Court and that the petitioner undertakes to appear on all future dates in her trial, unless specifically exempted.

Notice of motion.

Ms.Gunkirat Kaur, AAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Adjourned to 07.12.2021.

In the meanwhile subject to the petitioner's appearing before the Trial Court within one week from today she be admitted to ad interim bail to the Trial Court's satisfaction.”

As per the order of the Trial Court dated 09.11.2021 in pursuance to the afore-quoted order, the petitioner appeared before the Trial Court and on such appearance was admitted to interim bail to the Trial Court's satisfaction.

In the light of the reasons given in the afore-quoted order as also the subsequent developments noticed above, which clearly show the bonafides on the part of the petitioner, the order of this Court dated 02.11.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is ordered to be made absolute.
