Through this 2nd petition, the petitioner seeks regular bail in case bearing FIR No.46 dated 16.07.2019, registered under Sections 21, 22 of the NDPS Act, at Police Station Bakshiwala, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the FIR was registered on 16.07.2019 and since then the petitioner has been in custody. The challan has been presented, but out of 38 prosecution witnesses, only 03 have been examined till now. At this stage, he restricts his prayer to the extent of issuance of direction to the learned trial Court to conclude the trial within a stipulated period.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the learned trial Court, to make an endeavour to conclude the trial expeditiously in accordance with law.
