Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that in the present case, the petitioners have been transferred outside their cadre which transfer is totally arbitrary and illegal as no employee can be transferred outside the cadre.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further argues that the petitioners belongs to the cadre of “rest of Haryana” whereas, vide the impugned order the petitioners have been transferred to Mewat cadre which is impermissible.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the petitioners have any grievance qua the transfer, they can approach the competent authorities by filing appropriate representation within a period of two days from today and in case, any such grievance is raised, the same shall be decided within a period of 10 days thereafter by passing an appropriate speaking order. In case, the petitioners have not been relieved till today from the present place of posting then they will be allowed to continue at the present place of posting till the

decision of the said representation in case, the same is filed.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioners to approach the respondents by filing appropriate representation raising the grievance as raised in the present petition.

Ordered accordingly.
