This is the petitioner's 4th attempt to get bail during the pendency of the trial arising from case FIR No.222, dated 24.08.2019, registered under Section 22 and 25 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Sardulgarh, District Mansa.

As per the case of the prosecution, the petitioner along with his co-accused was apprehended with 6500 tablets containing Tramadol Hydrochloride chemical. The recovery from the petitioner falls under the commercial category.

The learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that co-accused of the petitioner namely Sushil Kumar @ Monu has been granted bail. On 11.05.2022, while dismissing the previous bail application, the aforesaid fact was taken into account and explained as under:-

“4. This Court has examined the order passed on 19.08.2020 in Criminal Misc. No. M-12847 of 2020. The bail was granted to Sushil Kumar alias Monu as no recovery was effected from him and he was involved in the case on the disclosure statement made by the petitioner. On the other hand, in the present case, the alleged recovery was effected from the petitioner. Hence, the aforesaid case is distinguishable.”

Hence, no ground to grant concession of bail is made out.

Dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
