[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 10.10.2018, in CWP No.19236 of 2013 in case titled as 'Tarvinder Kumar versus State of Punjab and others'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP No.19236 of 2013 was allowed, notification dated 23.12.2011 was set aside and the respondents directed to release same pay scale to the petitioner as allowed to other Vocational Masters with qualification of Bachelors Degree in Engineering as per notification dated 23.12.2011 along with all consequential benefits within two months from the date of receipt of copy of the order.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner on instructions from the petitioner states that needful having been done in terms of order (Annexure P-1) dated 10.10.2018, in CWP No.19236 of 2013, she does not press the instant petition.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
