The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.132 dated 19.10.2021 registered under Sections 323, 354, 406, 498-A, 506, 34 IPC at Police Station, Panjokhara, District Ambala.

By virtue of the order dated 3.11.2021 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance to the order dated 3.11.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation. Counsel submits that he has specifically informed his client for the compliance of the order by paying Rs.25,000/- as litigation expenses to the complainant, however, petitioner is not in a position to pay the amount.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jai Kumar has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant has however opposed the submissions made by counsel for petitioner.

In view of the above, the order dated 3.11.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petition stands allowed.
