The instant writ petition has been filed with a limited prayer for correcting the category of the petitioner herein, who had applied to be appointed as a Constable under the Ex-Servicemen SC (M&B) category.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein would contend that the petitioner herein belongs to Ex-Servicemen (Majhabi Sikh) category and he applied for the post of Constable in Ex-Servicemen SC category. However, he was treated in the category of Ex-Servicemen SC (R&O). It is contended that he had given all the necessary information to the respondents-State for treating him as Ex-Servicemen SC (M&B) category, however, his category was not corrected, which has necessitated the filing of the instant writ petition.

Pursuant to notice of motion having been issued on 29.11.2018, reply has been filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2, wherein it is

submitted that the process of correcting the category of the petitioner was undertaken. Today in Court, learned State counsel would submit that in fact, the necessary correction has been made and the process of issuing joinings in the Armed Police Cadre is underway.

In view of the above statement having been given, learned counsel for the petitioner herein does not press the instant writ petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
