[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 02.06.2022 in CWP No.12899 of 2022 in case titled as Gurnam Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.12899 of 2022 was disposed of with a direction to the respondent herein to consider and decide legal notice dated 21.03.2022 in accordance with law within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the issuance of notice, the respondent has rejected the claim of the petitioners as contained in legal notice dated 21.03.2022 vide order, Annexure R/1 dated 18.11.2022, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition but pray for grant of liberty to the petitioners to challenge order, Annexure R/1 dated 18.11.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instantpetition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.
