The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C.
for directing the State of Haryana to send respondent No.4 to Nari Niketan
in view of her tender age.

Notice of motion in this was issued on 17.11.2021, pursuant to
which reply dated 20.12.2021 by way of an affidavit of Subhash Chander
HPS, DSP, HQ, Kurukshetra has been filed.

Learned State counsel makes a reference to para-2 and 4, of
preliminary submissions, which reads as thus:-

*“2.That in compliance with the order dated 22.10.2021 the
Superintendent of Police HQ, Kurukshetra vide office*

Memo NO.687-DSP/Reader dated 28.10.2021 directed SHO Police Station Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra to ensure present petitioner), Jagmal Singh (the Poonam, Dharamvir, Kuldeep and Sandeep to appear on 2.11.2021 at 11:00 A.M. in his office. So that compliance of the order passed by this Hon'ble Court may be made in letter and spirit.

3. That as per notice dated 28.10.2021 the statement Panchal, of Poonam Sandeep Panchal, W/o Jagmal, Kuldeep Dharamvir Panchal and Jagmal Singh S/o Dharamvir Singh were recorded and in their statement. they categorically stated that their girl amely Simran may be sent to "Nari Niketan" and they have no objection qua the order passed by this Hon'ble court in the above noted CRWP."

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

In view of the above, the present petition has been disposed of as rendered infructuous. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to avail any alternate remedy, including to approach the learned Judicial Magistrate concerned.
