**VINOD S. BHARDWAJ, J. (Oral)**

The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to execute the sale deed in favour of the petitioner, since the entire amount of property auctioned by the respondent-department has already been paid.

Short reply by way of affidavit of Sandeep Gupta, Superintendent Engineer, Municipal Corporation, Abohar has been filed on behalf of respondent No.4 today in the Court. A copy thereof has been furnished to the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned Senior counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.4-Municipal Council, Abohar contends that the grievance of the

petitioner stands satisfied and that the sale deed qua the Plot No. 35 has been executed by the respondents in favour of the petitioner.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner does not dispute the aforesaid fact.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed as having been rendered infructuous.
