1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 25.07.2016, in CWP-28105-2013.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 reveals that liberty was granted to the petitioner to submit a representation to the State Government for reconsideration of the matter regarding acquisition of its land and building, either for its release and/order exchange of some other land having proper access from the main road so that the petitioner-trust could reconstruct the school at the new site and the writ petition was accordingly disposed of by directing the competent authority to take a decision in the matter within six months and till decision on the representation, dispossession of the petitioner was ordered to remain stayed.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the needful having been done in terms of order Annexure P/1 by accepting the claim of the petitioner vide notification dated 14.05.2020, besides costs of Rs.10,000/- in compliance with order dated 29.01.2020, having been paid by the respondent, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and prays for permission to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
