HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel appearing for the respondents-PSPCL submits that the benefit, which is being claimed by the petitioner in the present petition, i.e. counting of the period of work charge service, rendered by him with the respondents, while computing his pensionary benefits, has already been extended in favour of the petitioner and his pension has already been revised from Rs.7,136/- to Rs.9,910/- as far as back in the year 2017 and the revised gratuity amount has also been released to the petitioner on 05.07.2017. Learned counsel for the respondents further submits that all the benefits, for which the petitioner was found entitled for, have already been extended in his favour.

No one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to rebut the said statement of learned counsel for the respondents.

Keeping in view the reply filed by the respondents, as the relief

claimed in the present petition has already been extended in favour of the petitioner by the respondents, therefore, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court in the present case.

In case the petitioner feels that any of the benefits, for which he is entitled for, has not been extended in his favour by the respondents, he is at liberty to approach the respondents by filing an appropriate representation in this regard and in case, any such representation is filed by the petitioner, the respondents are directed to consider the said representation in accordance with law and decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of such representation.

Disposed of in the above terms.
