Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 204 dated 09.12.2018, registered under Sections 420, 406, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, at Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Vide order dated 30.08.2019 passed by a Coordinate Bench, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 30.08.2019, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No. 2 submits that the amount due to the petitioner has been paid to the Bank.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Avtar Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for any further investigation.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 30.08.2019 granting *ad interim* anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
