1. This order shall decide COCP-2956-2019 and COCP-2948-2019, as identical question is involved in the same. Facts of the case are being taken from COCP-2956-2019.

2. Prayer in the petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 28.05.2019, in CWP-14564-2019.

3. A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 dated 28.05.2019, reveals that CWP-14564-2019, was disposed of by directing the respondent- Executive Engineer, Construction Division, PWD (B&R), Pathankot, to examine the claim of the petitioner against the backdrop of legal notice dated 15.04.2019, expeditiously and in any case within eight weeks from

3. Learned counsel contends that although the instant petition was filed on account of the failure of the respondent to do the needful, but now the respondent has complied with order Annexure P/1 dated 28.05.2019 and has also made payment to the petitioner as per his entitlement pursuant to the decision of claim in legal notice dated 15.04.2019, therefore, the petitioner does not press the instant petition.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
