MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.34 dated 13.08.2021 under Sections 498-A and 406 IPC, registered at Police Station Nangal Bhoor, District Pathankot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on account of marital discord between the parties, the FIR in question came to be registered, however, later on, the matter was amicably settled between the parties. He further submits that a joint petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 has also been filed by the parties, in support thereof, he has annexed the copy of the petition filed under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act as Annexure P-1. He further submits that in compliance of order dated 01.11.2021, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rakesh

Kumar, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He on further instructions submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 01.11.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
