The petitioners through instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. are seeking direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to conduct fair and transparent investigation of FIR No.36 dated 23.06.2019 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 323, 324, 379, 506, 148 and 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sarai Amanat Khan, District Tarn Taran. The petitioners are further praying for direction to official respondents to take action against respondent Nos.4 to 9 on the basis of representation of the petitioners.

As per reply dated 28.10.2022 of the State, the matter has already been investigated and the final report is ready which would be presented in due course. As per investigation, petitioners and respondents have committed offence punishable under different Sections of IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioners on being confronted with

afore-stated facts submits that respondents may be directed to file challan in a time bound manner.

The prayer of the petitioners was confined to fair and transparent investigation of afore-stated FIR. The police in investigation has found petitioners as well as respondents accused of commission of cognizable offence and challan would be filed in due course.

In view of the above development and statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, no further order is warranted, however, the respondents are directed to file police report/cancellation report in terms of Section 173 of Cr.P.C. expeditiously and preferably within 2 months from today.
