Today, learned State counsel has informed that in the instant case all the PWs already stand examined and that the petitioner is involved in 15 more cases though he stands acquitted in 4 cases.

In view of the aforestated position, this Court does not find any ground for grant of regular bail to the petitioner at this fag end of the trial. The petition, as such, is dismissed.

However, in case there is inordinate delay in conclusion of trial, it shall be open to the petitioner to approach this Court again.

The trial Court is directed to take all such necessary steps as may be possible for expeditious conclusion of the trial provided the defence counsel fully cooperates the same.
