HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that the transfer of the petitioners has been effected vide order dated 28.08.2022, which is bad as after the transfer, the petitioners are being asked to discharge the duties of the subject for which they were never appointed for. Learned counsel submits that the petitioners are being asked to teach the subjects other than the subjects for which they have been appointed for, which is totally arbitrary and illegal. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioners have been transferred outside their cadre which transfer is totally arbitrary and illegal as no employee can be transferred outside their cadre.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that in case, any grievance qua the transfer or with regard to the fact that the petitioners are being asked to teach a subject for which they had never been appointed for or are not part of their duties, is filed by the petitioners by way of representation, the same shall be looked into by the authorities concerned and appropriate orders will

be passed expeditiously, preferably within a period of 4 weeks from the receipt of any such representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the aforesaid statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further, with liberty to the petitioners to approach the respondents by way of filing an appropriate representation raising their grievance.

Ordered accordingly.
