Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that the petitioners in the present petition are similarly situated as the petitioners in **CWP-1486-2018**, titled as ***“Kidar Nath Kohli and others Vs. State of Haryana and others”***, decided on 13.12.2018, hence they are also entitled for the grant of benefit under the Haryana Aided School (Special Pension and Contributory Provident Fund) Rules, 2001.

Learned counsels for the respondents concede the aforesaid factum at this stage and submit that claim of the petitioners, as raised in the present petition, will be considered by the authorities concerned by keeping in mind the judgment of this Court passed in **Kidar Nath Kohli's case** (supra) and an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of this order and after the

decision, in case the petitioners are found entitled for grant of any monetary

benefits, the said benefits will also be released in their favour within a period of four weeks thereafter.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the submissions of learned counsels for the respondents, as recorded hereinbefore, no further grievance of the petitioners remains in the present petition at this stage, and therefore, the same may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further at this stage.
