Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner was transferred vide order dated 28.08.2022 (Annexure P-1) and the petitioner joined at the transferred place on 01.09.2022 and now once again, within a period of one week, he has been transferred again vide order dated 06.09.2022 (Annexure P-3) without giving any reason, which act on the part of the respondents is totally arbitrary and illegal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance vide representation dated 11.09.2022 (Annexure P-4), which is still pending consideration of the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage if the respondents are directed to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that the representation dated 11.09.2022 (Annexure P-4) moved by the petitioner will be decided by passing an appropriate order keeping in view the transfer policy. In case, the petitioner

has not been relieved till today from the present place of posting then he will be allowed to continue at the present place of posting till the decision of the said representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
