In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that while calculating the merit of the petitioner for effecting the transfer, the petitioner was given 61.32 marks whereas, the petitioner was entitled for 5 more marks falling under a couple case. Learned counsel submits that without adjudging the correct merit, the petitioner has been transferred and the option given by the petitioner of a particular station has been extended to respondent No. 4, who scored less marks than the petitioner, in case 5 marks are added to the petitioner being a couple case.

Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner had already raised the said grievance before the authorities concerned by way of representation (Annexure P-5) but the respondents did not remove the said discrepancy and the petitioner has been transferred to a far off place instead against the post, which was opted by her, which post should have been given to the petitioner keeping in view her merits.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that a representation (Annexure P-5) given by the petitioner will be considered in accordance with law and shall be decided within a period of 10 days from today thereafter by passing an appropriate speaking order. Till then, the petitioner shall not be relieved from the present place of posting or in case relieved, will not be forced to join the new place of posting till the decision of the said representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondent by filing appropriate representation raising the grievance as raised in the present petition.

Ordered accordingly.
