By this order, two petitions, the detail of which have been given in the head note, are being disposed of having same question of law on similar facts.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner was transferred vide order dated 28.08.2022 on which post, the petitioner joined but within a period of 7 days, again the petitioner has been transferred on 01.09.2022 and that too without any valid reason. Learned counsel further submits that the transfer of the petitioner within a span of 7 days of previous transfer is totally arbitrary and illegal and contrary to the transfer policy itself. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits

that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance qua the transfer dated 01.09.2022 vide representation dated 02.09.2022 (Annexure P-6) which is still pending consideration and the petitioners will be satisfied at this stage in case, a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that the grievance of the petitioner as raised in the representation shall be decided within a period of 10 days from today by passing an appropriate speaking order. Till then, the petitioner shall not be relieved from the present place of posting or in case relieved, will not be forced to join the new place of posting till the decision of the said representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
