The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.126 dated 05.06.2020 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 474, 475, 476 and 120-B IPC at Police Station City-1, District Abohar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 17.08.2021, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kulvinder Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.
