Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner was transferred vide order dated 28.08.2022 and he joined at the place of transfer but immediately within a period of two days, another person has been posted at the place of the petitioner vide impugned order of reallocation dated 01.09.2022 and the petitioner has been left without any place of posting, which act on the part of the respondent-authorities is contrary to law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance by way of representation dated 02.09.2022 (Annexure P-11), which is pending consideration of the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied in case the said representation is decided by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that as of now, he does not have any instruction as to why another person has been

transferred to the place where the petitioner joined, within 02 days of his posting but he assures that the representation dated 02.09.2022 (Annexure P-11) filed by the petitioner will be considered in accordance with law, coupled with the transfer policy and an appropriate order on the said representation will be passed within a period of 10 days from the receipt of copy of this order and till the claim of the petitioner is decided by the competent authority, the petitioner will be allowed to continue at the place of posting where he was posted vide order dated 28.08.2022.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel no further grievance of the petitioner survives and the present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
