The petitioner has impugned the order dated 08.09.2022 (Annexure P-11) whereby she has been transferred from Adarsh School Seerwali-Bangewala to Adarsh School, Raniwala in an arbitrary manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the transfer has been made at the behest of respondent No.4 to accommodate her at Adarsh School Seerwali-Bangewala.

Issue notice to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

Mr. Anupam Singla, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and submits that as a complaint had been received against the petitioner, she has been transferred as a temporary arrangement till the conclusion of the fact finding enquiry. He also submits that the fact finding enquiry shall be concluded within a period of one month.

Heard.

In view of the above especially when the transfer is a temporary arrangement, I do not find any ground to interfere while exercising writ jurisdiction. However, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to conclude the fact finding enquiry within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and in the event of the petitioner being exonerated in the enquiry, the official respondents shall consider her posting at the previous place.
