The present petition has been instituted for seeking the writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing the respondents to conduct an inquiry and to demarcate khasra No.2021, the possession whereof has purportedly been handed over to the private respondent under the garb of a sale deed executed qua separate khasra number.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, does not controvert the fact that the dispute in question is a private dispute *inter se* between the petitioner and the private respondents not having involved any public law.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take recourse to the alternative remedies available to him in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as aforesaid.
