AMAN CHAUDHARY. J. (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed under Section 482 CrPC for issuance of directions to the respondents to take action and arrest of the accused person in FIR No.191 dated 12.08.2020 registered under Sections 427, 447, 457, 506, 148 and 149 of the IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act at Police Station Lopoke District Amritsar.

Notice of motion was issued on 16.12.2020, pursuant thereto, reply dated 31.01.2021 by way of affidavit of Gurpartap Singh Sahota, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Attari, Amritsar-Rural has been filed. Learned State counsel refers to para 8 which reads thus:

“8. That it is humbly submitted that in view of the submissions made hereinabove, it is evident that the aforesaid Case FIR No. 191, dated 12.08.2020, under Sections 427/ 447/ 457/ 506/ 148/149 IPC, 25, 27/54/59 Arms Act, Police Station Lopoke, Amritsar Rural has been registered in pursuance to the applications given by the petitioner with respect to the occurrence as mentioned in paragraph no. 2 of the present petition. During investigation, total 11 accused persons have

so far been nominated as accused in this case, out of which, one was arrested and four accused, who have been granted relief of interim bail by the Court of Ld. Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar, have joined the investigation and strenuous efforts are being made to arrest the remaining accused. The investigation of the present case is being carried out fairly and impartially in a transparent manner and it shall be taken to its logical conclusion and final investigation report under Section 173 (2) Cr.P.C. shall be filed before the Ld. Court of competent jurisdiction. The SHO Police Station Lopoke, has been directed to ensure protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members. Therefore, the present petition is liable to be dismissed.”

Learned State counsel further submits on instruction from ASI Gurwinder Singh that besides 11 accused mentioned in the aforesaid para, 11 more accused have joined the investigation and challan stands filed. He therefore submits that appropriate action has been taken by investigating the matter.

This satisfies the learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, no further action is required to be passed.

Disposed of.
