HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (Oral)

In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that they have been transferred outside their cadre which is not permissible keeping in view the rule governing the service as, under the Haryana State Education School Cadre (Group B) Service Rules, 2012, there are two cadres, (i) 'Rest of Haryana Cadre' (ii) 'Mewat Cadre' and the posts in these two cadres are not inter transferable, hence effecting the transfer of the petitioner by the respondent is totally arbitrary, illegal and beyond their jurisdiction.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the petitioner has any grievance qua the transfer, the petitioner is at liberty to move appropriate representation raising the said grievance within a period of two days from today and in case, any such grievance is raised, the same

shall be decided within a period of 10 days thereafter by passing an appropriate speaking order and the petitioners will not be relieved from the present place of posting or in case relieved, will not be forced to join the new place of posting till the decision of the said representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondent by filing appropriate representation raising the grievance as raised in the present petition.

Ordered accordingly.
