Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though the present writ petition has been filed seeking the benefit of seniority for the adhoc service rendered by the petitioners but as the claim of the petitioners is still pending consideration with the respondents keeping in view the legal notice dated 10.10.2018 (Annexure P-4), the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Learned counsel for the respondents raises no objection in deciding the legal notice of the petitioners dated 10.10.2018 (Annexure P-4) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioners for the relief which has been claimed by them in the legal notice dated 10.10.2018 (Annexure P-4), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice dated 10.10.2018 (Annexure P-4) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
