1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 08.04.2021, in CWP-7973-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 reveals that CWP-7973-2021, was disposed of by directing the competent authority to consider and decide the claim of the petitioners as contained in legal notice served by them by passing a speaking order within four months, from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and further by directing that in case the petitioners were found entitled to the claim as raised in legal notice, then the same be disbursed to them within two months thereafter.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that claim as contained in legal notice served by them has been decided vide order Annexure R/1 dated 08.03.2022 and payment as per entitlement determined therein, has also been released to the petitioners, therefore, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971
