On 07.07.2022, on behalf of the appellant statement (separately recorded), was made by learned counsel for the appellant to accept Rs.60,000/- (Rupees Sixty thousand only) more, over and above, the amount awarded by the MACT concerned, in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. Today, on behalf of the Insurance Company concurrence has been given to this effect.

Today, learned counsel for the appellant has apprised this Forum that the appellant-Mahavir has died and now in view of the settlement he will file an application for bringing on record the legal representatives of the appellants before the concerned Executive Court/MACT and also for release of the settled amount.

Learned counsel for the Insurance Company agrees to deposit the settled amount before the concerned Executive Court/MACT, Panipat.

Accordingly, Rs.60,000/- (Rupees Sixty thousand only) is allowed over and above the compensation already awarded by the MACT.

We dispose of this case with a direction to the parties to do the needful within a period of two months. After impleading the LRs of the appellant before the Executive Court/MACT, Panipat, the Insurance Company should deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of Rs.60,000/- (Rupees Sixty thousand only) in the name of the LRs of the appellant before the Executive Court/MACT, Panipat within 30 days from the date of order of concerned Executive Court/MACT, failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a., till the cheque is deposited before the MACT.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied /sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
