In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that he is entitled for the grant of 3rd ACP after completing 20/30 years of regular service, which service the petitioner completed in the year 2015 but, he has been given the benefit of 3rd ACP from a date subsequent to the said date, which is causing prejudice to him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that as there was nothing adverse against the petitioner so as to deny the benefit of 3rd ACP from the due date, respondents are liable to be directed to grant the said benefit from the year 2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the legal notice dated 13.11.2019 (Annexure P-2), which is still pending consideration with the respondents

and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to respondent No. 2 to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Raman Kumar Sharma, learned Addl. Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the legal notice dated 13.11.2019 (Annexure P-2) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the pleadings in the present petition, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the legal notice, respondent No. 2 is directed to decide the legal notice dated 13.11.2019 (Annexure P-2), by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
