The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.121 dated 17.10.2021 registered under Sections 306, 34 IPC (Section 304-B IPC added vide order dated 19.4.2022), at Police Station Mulepur, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

By virtue of the order dated 3.11.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners have joined the investigation and fully cooperated and as such the interim bail granted to the petitioner be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant opposed the submission made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Mann Singh, has endorsed the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 3.11.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
