Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the petitioner had not qualified the required HTET examination prior to the last date of application but the said qualification was obtained before the date of interview hence, keeping in view the past precedent where, similarly situated candidates have been given relaxation in similar regard, the said

relaxation also needs to be extended to the petitioner so as to avoid any discrimination.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any request is made by the petitioner citing any precedent or alleging any discrimination, the same will be considered in accordance with law and appropriate order on the same will be passed within a period of eight weeks of receipt of the same.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the above, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.

Ordered accordingly.
