While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed:-

“Apprehending his arrest in FIR No.0019 dated 23.01.2022 for offences punishable under Sections 353, 186, 427, 323, 336, 34 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Div.A, Police Commissionerate, District Amritsar, the petitioner has preferred this petition under Section 438 Cr. P.C seeking pre-arrest bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioners inter alia contends that infact it is a case of brawl and the injuries alleged to have been caused are simple in nature.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court Mr. Sarabjit Singh Cheema, DAG.,Punjab who is present in Court accepts notice.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail subject to their furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. As and when called, the petitioners shall join the investigation. They shall abide by the conditions enumerated under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

To come up on 20.12.2022.”

2. Today, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Lakhwinder Singh, submits that the petitioners have joined investigation and are no more required for custodial interrogation.

3. In view of above, the interim order dated 15.09.2022 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to the conditions as enumerated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

4. Petition stands disposed off.
