Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.126 dated 15.09.2016, registered for offences under Sections 66 and 66-A of Information Technology Act, 2000 (for short “I.T. Act”) and Sections 506 and 509 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, however, later on Section 67 of I.T. Act was added, at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur, Annexure P-1, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the compromise dated 23.05.2019, Annexure P-2, arrived at between the parties.

Although, the statements of the parties have been recorded in pursuance to order passed by this Court, but when confronted with the allegations levelled in the FIR and the final report submitted by the Investigating Agency, counsel for the petitioner has sought and is granted permission to withdraw the petition.
