In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that the petitioner has been transferred before the completion of minimum stay of five years at the present place of posting, which act of the respondents is contrary to the transfer policy as well as judgment of the Coordinate Bench of this Court in *CWP-15108-2021 titled as Vikram Singh and others vs. State of Haryana and others decided on 24.08.2021.*

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is entitled to continue at the present place of posting and the transfer of respondent No.4 at the place of posting of the petitioner is totally arbitrary and illegal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance by filing a representation

dated 05.09.2022 (Annexure P-9) which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that representation dated 05.09.2022 (Annexure P-9) filed by the petitioner, if not already decided, will be decided within a period of next 10 days and till the decision on the representation, the petitioner will be allowed to stay at the present place of posting in case not already relieved and in case, the petitioner is relieved, she will not be forced to join the new place of posting.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, no further grievance of the petitioner survives and the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
