Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner was transferred on 28.08.2022 and the petitioner joined on the said place but within a period of 7 days, the petitioner had again been transferred vide order dated 01.09.2022 which act of the respondent is totally arbitrary and illegal. Learned counsel further submits that the second transfer of the petitioner is within a period of 7 days of previous transfer and without completing the minimum period, hence, the transfer order dated 01.09.2022 (Annexure P-7) qua the petitioner is liable to be set aside. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance qua the transfer dated 01.09.2022 vide representation (Annexure P-11) which is still pending consideration and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case, a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that the grievance raised by the petitioner in the representation (Annexure P-11) will be considered by a competent authority and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of 10 days from today and the petitioner will not be relieved from the present place of posting or in case relieved, will not be forced to join the new place of posting till the decision of the said representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
