HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (Oral)

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that keeping in view the policy of the Government of Haryana dated 04.03.2020, as amended on 11.05.2022, the petitioner is entitled for adjustment as an extension lecturer in the subject of commerce which benefit has not been extended to the petitioner. Learned counsel further submits that while passing the order dated 20.07.2021 by the Principle, a copy of which as been annexed as Annexure P-7, actual facts have not been noticed. It is further submitted that after passing of the order Annexure P-7, the policy dated 04.03.2020 has been further amended, according to which the petitioner is very much eligible for readjustment as an extension lecturer, hence the respondents are under obligation to consider the claim of the petitioner in view of the amendment dated 11.05.2022.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that after the

amendment of the policy on 11.05.2022, the petitioner has already filed a representation dated 20.08.2022 (Annexure P-9) for consideration of claim afresh which representation is pending before the respondent as of now and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case, a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that representation dated 20.08.2022 (Annexure P-9), if not already decided, will be decided in accordance with law within a period of 8 weeks of receipt of copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
