The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 0233 dated 10.09.2015, registered under Sections 323, 324 and 34 of the IPC at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

The operative part of the order dated 11.11.2021, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“ Counsel for the petitioner submits that though, the allegations against the petitioner are of causing injuries near the right eye, which has invoke Section 326 IPC, however, in order to explore the possibility of some settlement, the petitioner is ready to pay Rs.35,000/- to the victim.

List again on 14.02.2022.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 11.11.2021, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has handed over a demand draft of Rs.35,000/- favouring the victim namely Ram.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Santokh Singh, has not disputed the abovesaid fact and has acknowledged the same and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 11.11.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
